India – ASEAN: A Snapshot

- India's relationship with ASEAN countries is the foundation of our foreign policy as well as our "Act East Policy"
- India has a Free Trade Agreement (FTA) with ASEAN
- Post India-ASEAN FTA, total trade between expanded substantially from US\$ 45.34 billion in 2008-09 to nearly US\$ 81 billion in 2017-18
- India and ASEAN economies are some of the most dynamic emerging economies
- ASEAN's combined GDP of US\$ 2.4 trillion makes it the 3rd largest economy in Asia and 7th largest in the world
- Geographical proximity and strong and cordial political and cultural linkages paves way for greater economic integration
- Also engaged in negotiations to conclude the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP)
