# NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)

The High Commission of India invites bids from selected firms for carrying out repair works in aircon system at a heritage bungalow at No. 2 Pierce Road, Singapore.

## Scope of work

The scope of work includes following:-

- 1. To supply labour, materials and tools to carry out the following works.
  - (a) Re-run One (1) length of new refrigerant piping with insulations, piping connections, brazing and vacuum system.
  - (b) Cut ceiling opening to make way for replacement AC works.
  - (c) Dismantle Two (2) Nos. of existing Fan Coil (2-6 and 2-7) unit and dispose away from site.
  - (d) Replace Two (2) Nos. of New Toshiba (MMD-AP0366BHP1-E) Ducted type fan coil unit or equivalent.
  - (e) Modify existing Ductworks and Pipe work to fit the new FCU. (2-6 and 2-7)
  - (f) Install Seven (7) Nos. of Toshiba Y Joints for indoor FCU connect to new refrigerant joints.
  - (g) Charge-in refrigerant gas for the system and test run.
- 2. Replace One (1) No. of Compressor (model MMY-MAP0801T8) c/w vacuum system, brazing work and wiring connection.
- 3. To arrange Toshiba to resetting configuration programming for the system due to mixture of existing and new FCU.

### II. Completion of work

a. After completion, re-install all removed items. Exceptional care must be taken to assure tidiness of work. Suitable temporary covers, masking, drop sheets, drapes and/or barriers shall be provided and maintained effectively where necessary to protect carpeting and furniture to ensure that they are not put at risk. These are to be removed when the protection is no longer required.

- b. Upon completion of the work all repair materials, containers, debris and protective coverings shall be cleaned up and removed from site and the Contractor shall leave the area in a clean, neat, and orderly condition satisfactory to the Contracting Officer.
- III. The premises and the work to be carried out may be inspected with prior appointment. Please call Tel. No. 62382536/35 for fixing appointment for viewing the premises.
- **IV. Liquidated Damage Clause:** After award of work, the contractor shall start the work at the earliest and the work shall be completed within two weeks. A penalty of 0.5% of contract value for delay of each day shall be applied, subject to a maximum of 10% of contract value.
- **V.** The contractor shall not further sub contract the whole or any part of the contract, under any circumstances to third party. The Contractor should satisfy himself about scope of work before submitting the bid. In case of any dispute, the decision of High Commission of India shall be final. No deviation in specification shall be allowed and no extra claim shall be entertained for any unforeseen work.
- VI. No claim from the contractor for any additional payment on account of local Singapore laws or on restricted working hours shall be entertained. The contractor must quote according to local laws and conditions at site.
- VII. The Contractor shall ensure that all local labour laws and other relevant provisions are fulfilled and insurance provisions are made for the safety of workers at site.
- VIII. Financial bids may be sent by email to "hoc.singapore@mea.gov.in" or in sealed envelopes addressed to "Head of Chancery, High Commission of India, No. 31 Grange Road, Singapore 239702 latest by 04<sup>th</sup> April 2022 (10AM).
- IX. The bidder is required to submit earnest deposit of S\$ 500.00 by way of bank guarantee or fixed deposits. The EMD shall be returned to unsuccessful bidders after completion of process of award of work. In lieu of EMD, bidders can also submit undertaking in the given format at 'Annexure A'.
- X. An amount of 5% of contract valve will be retained as security deposit, 50% of security deposit (2.5% of contract value) shall be released after one month of completion of work, and balance shall be released only after one year of completion of work. The security deposit can be in form of bankers' cheque, fixed deposit receipt, account payee demand draft or Bank guarantee and should remain valid for a period of one year after the completion of work. This period of one year shall be 'Defect Liability Period' and any defects observed during this period shall be made

good by the Contractor without any charges. The Security Deposit shall be fortified if the Contractor does not rectify damages within two weeks.
