NOTICE INVITING TENDER

1. The High Commission of India invites financial bids from reputed companies registered in Singapore for the following work at No. 31 Grange Road, Singapore 239702.

i)	<p>Providing, fixing and installing PVC chain link iron mesh boundary fencing including concrete base footing for iron angles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Front elevation of approximately 38-metre length of fencing of 2.4 metre vertical height with additional 0.4 metre top fencing at an angle (see sketch) with galvanized steel post at not more than 2.4 metres apart;• Construct new retaining wall with necessary sub-structure designed, and certified by Structural Engineer Qualified Person;• From Gate No 2 facing Leonie Hill Road, approximately 44-metre length of fencing of 2.4 metre vertical height with additional 0.4 metre top fencing at an angle (see sketch) with galvanized steel post at not more than 2.4 metres apart;• To remove any roots of existing trees and debris that affect the above construction and/or as a result of the above construction.	

2. The Contractor will liaise with the concerned authorities on behalf of High Commission for obtaining requisite permission for (i) construction of fencing (ii) removal of roots/branches of trees inside along the perimeter of the premises.

3. The premises and the work to be carried out may be inspected from Monday to Friday from 1000 hrs to 1600 hrs. Please contact 62382536 (Mr. Sundram, Attache (Admin)) for fixing appointment for viewing the premises and understanding various aspects of work.

4. After award of work, the work shall be carried out within three weeks.
5. A rough sketch of the work to be carried out is enclosed with this NIT.
6. The repair and replacement work of PVC chain link/iron post/concrete base/brick work shall be of specification same as that of the existing one.
7. The Contractor should satisfy himself about scope of work before submitting the bid. In case of any dispute, the decision of High Commission of India shall be final. No deviation in specification shall be allowed and no extra claim shall be entertained for any unforeseen work.
8. An amount of 10% of total bill will be retained as security deposit and shall be released only after one year of completion of work. This period of one year shall be 'Defect Liability Period' and any defects observed during this period shall be made good by the Contractor without any charges. The Security Deposit of 10% shall be fortified if the Contractor does not rectify damages within two weeks.
9. No claim from the contractor for any additional payment on account of local Singapore laws or on restricted working hours shall be entertained. The contractor must quote according to local laws and conditions at site.
10. The work shall be carried out in such a manner that no part of the fencing is open after the office hours. The Contractor shall ensure that site is well protected and secured during all the time. No extra charges will be paid for this to the Contractor.
11. The Contractor shall ensure that all local labour laws and other relevant provisions are fulfilled and insurance provisions are made for the safety of workers at site.
